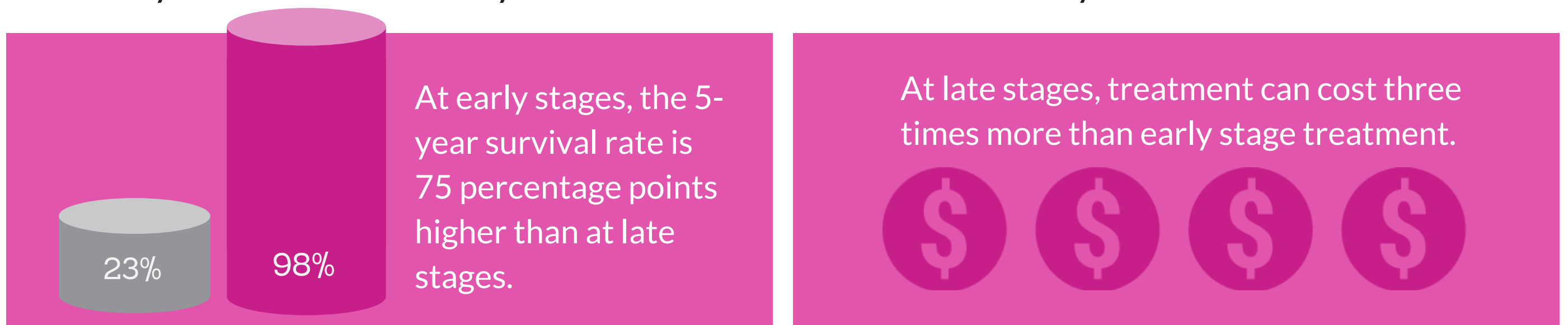




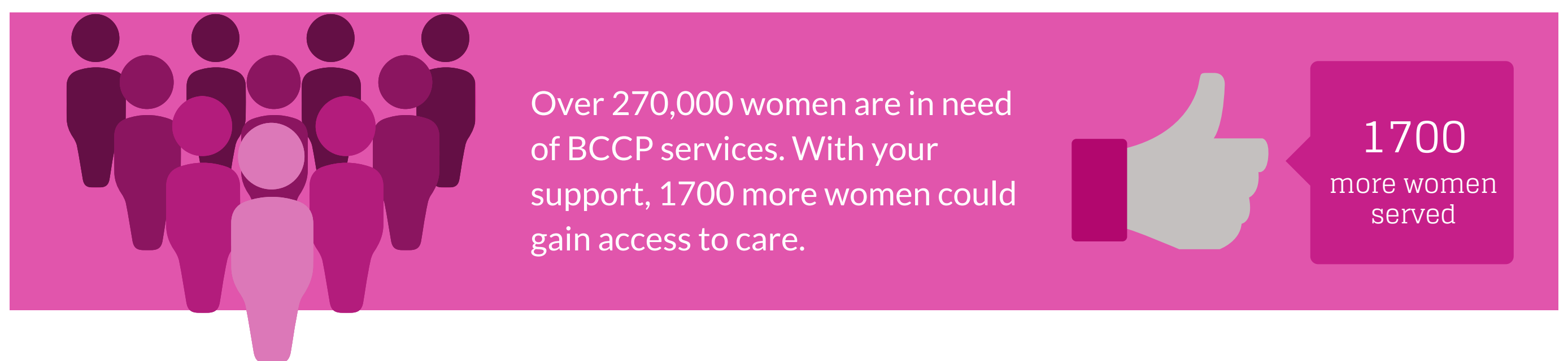
CHECK A BOX SAVE A LIFE

You have the power to save a life, by simply checking a box on your 2014 tax return. Ohio taxpayers will be able to donate a portion of their state income tax refund directly to Ohio's Breast and Cervical Cancer Program (BCCP).

Why? Women in Ohio are dying from breast cancer at a higher rate than the rest of the U.S. Early detection is the key to survival and saves Ohio money.



How does BCCP help? The program provides breast and cervical cancer screening and diagnostic services to low-income women in Ohio. BCCP is a critical and lifesaving safety net for the working poor in our state.



What can you do?

You can voluntarily contribute any portion of your eligible state tax refund directly to BCCP to support breast cancer screenings.
